APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be full-time classroom teachers, departmental supervisors, or librarians in New Jersey schools. Educators who have participated in a Teacher Institute seminar are not eligible to apply again for the same seminar.

Richard Stockton College Campus

The New Jersey Council for the Humanities Teacher Institute summer seminars will be held on the campus of The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey in Pomona, minutes from the shore and Atlantic City. Amenities include private air-conditioned residential facilities, meals, access to the University library, computer labs, work-out facilities and beautiful grounds.

How to Apply

1. Print out and complete the application form.
2. Submit a brief résumé.
3. In two pages or less, describe why you are applying to the seminar. Briefly note other NJCH seminars attended.
4. Submit a letter of recommendation from your principal or department chair.
5. **Rolling admissions begin immediately and continue until June 1, 2010.** Seminar space is limited; please apply early. You will be notified within approximately two weeks.
6. A \$100 registration fee is required of all accepted applicants. Do not send a check until you have been notified of acceptance.
